760 Food services Management (prev. 3300)

Students in the School district shall have an opportunity to participate in school lunch, breakfast, and milk programs. These programs shall be administered by the superintendent, established by the administration, the Board, state and federal laws, and designed in accordance with quidelines.

Food service prices shall be established at the Annual Meeting based on a recommendation by the Board. In accordance with federal guidelines, the district shall offer free and reduced price food services to students who qualify.

NOTIFICATION PROCEDURES FOR FOOD SERVICE

- Any account that has \$5 or less will be notified by the automated phone caller.
- For any account which has more than a negative \$30 will be sent a letter from the Food Service Director.
- For families which have more than a negative \$30 in the account, the student(s) will be served a sandwich and a carton of milk at no charge.
- Parents are encouraged to make payment plans with the Food Service Director.
